

Works notification

St Kilda Road resurfacing nightworks Domain Precinct

8pm - 5am, Tuesday 26 July and Wednesday 27 July 2022

Overnight road resurfacing works will take place in July on a section of the southbound lane of St Kilda Road between Albert Road and Bromby Street. As these works require a temporary closure of the southbound lane of St Kilda Road, they will need to occur at night outside of peak periods.

During the overnight works, there will be a closure of the southbound lane on St Kilda Road between Dorcas Street and Toorak Road, with traffic detours in place between Dorcas Street and Kings Way.

Road resurfacing will involve excavating a layer of the current road surface then applying layers of crushed rock and asphalt. Excavators, tandem trucks and vibratory rollers will be in use and medium level construction noise is expected. Once the resurfacing and line marking works are complete, concrete barriers will be shifted to realign the southbound lane on St Kilda Road between Albert Road and Bromby Street slightly east.

What we are doing

Traffic setup

- Closing the southbound lane on St Kilda Road between Dorcas Street and Toorak Road between 8pm and 5am on 26 and 27 July
- Closing the right hand turn from Park Street into St Kilda Road
- Setting up traffic control on the corners of St Kilda Road and Dorcas Street, St Kilda Road and Toorak Road/Kings Way, and St Kilda Road and Park Street.

Construction activity

- Excavating the existing roadway at the two tie-in points

- Backfilling works including applying crushed rock, asphalt and line marking to tie-in the new section of the southbound lane on St Kilda Road between Bowen Lane and Bromby Street
- Shifting concrete barriers to realign the southbound lane slightly east between Albert Road and Bromby Street.

What to be aware of

- Nightworks on 26 and 27 July between 8pm and 5am with medium levels of noise expected
- There will be no right turn from Park Street into St Kilda Road between 8pm and 5am on 26 and 27 July
- There will be no right turn from Dorcas Street into St Kilda Road between 8pm and 5am on 26 and 27 July
- The left turn from Park Street into St Kilda Road will remain open
- A traffic detour will be in place via Dorcas Street and Kings Way
- To reduce impacts to traffic and the community, these works will occur at night between 8pm and 5am outside of peak periods
- During this time the southbound bicycle lane on St Kilda Road will be closed between Park Street and Bromby Street with a temporary detour through the Shrine of Remembrance and along the existing shared path on St Kilda Road

- Cyclists will need to dismount while detouring through the Shrine Grounds
- Tram services will not be affected.
